Your SAC has some exciting news! Our application for the provincial Innovation Fund Grant was APPROVED! We were rewarded the funds to be used toward our project to supply a Book Vending Machine at our Eaglewood site.

The Book Vending Machine Project is a creative and engaging way to encourage reading and students to work toward their goals. The machine would be stocked with school-selected and approved literature (in both English and French) that would be curated for various age groups and reading levels within the school. The tokens needed to access books in the machine would be disbursed based on meeting individual, student-led goals and attainable for each student based on where they are (academic or social, so that everyone has success). The Book Vending Machine Project would only be the second of its kind in Atlantic Canada.

We will keep you up to date as we move forward with this exciting project!

October marked our first SAC meeting of the 2025/2026 school year, where we have approved funds to be allocated toward math and literacy tools and initiatives, such as decodable books, Handwriting Without Tears kits, and sub-release time to support math fact fluency assessments.
